By following this simple guide, you can make your first trip to the laundry room a successful one! Gather your supplies (laundry hamper, dirty clothes, detergent, and dryer sheets) and head over to your campus laundry room!

How to Wash



Add detergent. Place 2 tablespoons of liquid detergent in the soap drawer or toss one laundry pod in the machine.



Sort clothing by color and soil level, and be sure to empty your pockets!



Place your clothing without over filling into the washtub.



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Select cycle and push start to begin washing.



How to Dry

Clean the lint filter and place your wet clothing into the dryer.



Add a dryer sheet to reduce static and add softness.



Close the dryer door securely and select the temperature.



Push start to begin drying.



LAUNDRY ROOM TIPS & Tricks



Leave washer doors open after use to help the washer dry out quickly.



Always remove your clothes promptly from the machines so others can use them.



Clean up any spills that may have occured while you are in the laundry room.



Report out of order machines. Download the CSC ServiceWorks Service App for easy reporting.

Help your clothing to last longer:



Sort clothing by color and soil level.

Address stains quickly. When treating a stain, work from the outside in to prevent spreading.

Always check your tags to determine how the clothes should be washed and dried.

- Do not dry comforters, pillows, or large bulky items as it may damage your items.
- **Do not overload** the machines as it may damage your clothes as well as the machine(s). Leave 5 inches of space at the top of the machine.

Wash with Cold Water

Cold water cleans effectively and saves energy since up to 90% of the energy used for washing goes into heating the water.



Use HE Detergent

High Efficiency detergent and pods do not contain phosphates that are harmful to the environment.



Clean the lint filter

A clogged lint filter can increase the drying time up to 30%.



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
